



## One to One Math Program 2019

Our math programs offer one to one teaching for students age 3 to adult.

These programs focus on improving numeracy, beginning with pre-literacy and numeracy skills such as matching and sorting and progressing to include skills such as number recognition, one to one correspondence, numerical order, addition, subtraction and money. Concepts such as before, next, after, and more, less, equal are also introduced and weaved into each skill area.

Teachers work to develop the skills that are most useful and necessary in everyday life using a balanced approach in which multiple concepts are developing at the same time and the individual student's needs and interests are incorporated.

Students are involved with activities that provide practice of skills in various contexts and opportunities to use the numeracy skills they are building in meaningful ways.

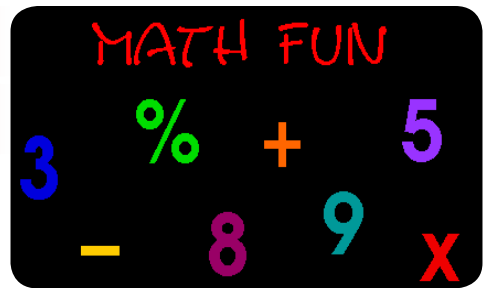


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## One to One Math Program (cont.)
