



# One to One Math Instruction

Our **math program** offers one to one instruction for students age 3 to adult. This program focuses on improving numeracy, beginning with pre-literacy and numeracy skills such as matching and sorting, and progressing to include skills such as number recognition, one to one correspondence, numerical order, addition, subtraction and money. Concepts such as before, next, after, and more, less, equal are also introduced.

Teachers work to develop the skills that are most useful and necessary in everyday life using a balanced approach in which multiple concepts are developing at the same time and the individual student's needs and interests are incorporated. Students practice skills in various contexts and use the numeracy skills they are building in meaningful ways.

This program prepares students to more fully participate in classroom activities at school and complement school based learning through: assessment, program design, material preparation for both in-class and take home, modelling for other members of the student's support team, and charting the course for continued progression.

One to One Math is offered in weekly individual sessions, at a price of \$61 per session. An optional assessment report is available for \$60.
